Larry holds an MBA in finance and investment from New York University. Larry is a known advocate of evidence based investing and promotes developing a strategic, disciplined financial plan. He recommends relying on long-term passive investments like index funds, instead of actively managed funds. He also cautions against making mistakes caused by behavioral biases.¹
